

PENALTY

Section 7-38-17(H) of the law provides a penalty which states in part as follows: "any person ... intentionally claiming and receiving the benefit of an exemption to which he is not entitled ... is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000)..."
