AMENDING RESOLUTION 2018-23
REVISING THE 2018-2019 COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acted in its regularly scheduled meeting on September 18, 2019 to adopt the **County Road Improvement Program** for 2018-2019; and desires of the state Department of Transportation (NMDOT) to accept the same; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Commission to prioritize road improvements based on road conditions, classification and the needs of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the NMDOT has requested that Valencia County utilize all available funding sources at its discretion for County road improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the County for the County Commission to upgrade its road system, and endorse an aggressive Road Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Project No. SP-3-19(933) Control No. HW2-L300225 with a total project cost of \$323,017.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$80,754.00 and New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$242,263.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$323,017.00.

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Project No. SB-7719(983) Control No. HW2-L300226 with a total project cost of \$474,667.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$118,667.00 and New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$356,000.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$474,667.00.

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Project No. CAP-3-19(402) HW2-L300224 with a total project cost of \$286,008.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share will be 25% or \$71,502.00 and New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$214,506.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$286,008.00.

WHEREAS, the originally proposed road improvements on Victoria Street, Morgan Road, Dalies Road, Bonita Loop, Monica Road & Silva Road are no longer a priority as these road improvements were funded utilizing bond money.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of Valencia County that:

1. The 2018-2019 **County Road Improvement Program** is of a high priority and is predicated off current needs and road conditions
2. The County will enter into Cooperative Agreements Control Number HW2-L300224, HW2-L300225 and HW2-L300226 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for LGRF Project for year 2018 – 2019 to improve the roads (see attached breakdown for scope of work and termini) within the control of Valencia County in Los Lunas, New Mexico.



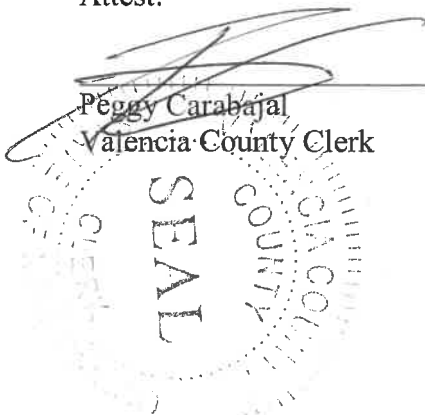
