PHASE 1B

- Persons 75+
- Persons 16+ at risk of COVID complications
- Frontline essential workers unable to work remotely: Early education and K-12 educators/staff, caregivers, grocery stores, food and agriculture, public transit, critical manufacturing, public health, public safety, mortuaries, indigent care, non-hospital laboratories
- Vulnerable populations: Residents of congregate settings¹

*Winter - Spring



PHASE 1C

- Adults 60+
- Other essential workers unable to work remotely: Transport and logistics, utilities, energy, water and wastewater, food service, retail, shelter and housing, financial services, IT and communications, energy, legal and accounting, media, veterinary and livestock services

Members of the general public (age 16+)
