**A RESOLUTION  
ADOPTING THE 2014 VALENCIA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, April 16, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. in the Valencia County Administration Building 444 Luna Avenue, Los Lunas, New Mexico 87031; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 4-38-13 (1953) provides that board of county commissioners shall have power at any session to make such orders concerning the property belonging to the county as they may deem expedient; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Sections 4-37-1 *et seq.* provides that counties may adopt those resolutions and ordinances, not inconsistent with statutory or constitutional limitations placed on counties, to discharge those powers necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity and improve the morals, order, comfort and convenience of the county and its inhabitants; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 67-2-1 (1905) defines public highways as “[a]ll roads and highways, except private roads, established in pursuance of any law of New Mexico, and roads dedicated to public use, that have not been vacated or abandoned, and such other roads as are recognized and maintained by the corporate authorities of any county in New Mexico, are hereby declared to be public highways”; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 67-2-2 (1905) provides that “[a]ll public highways, except such as are owned and operated by private corporations, and highways within the corporate limits of any incorporated city or town, shall be maintained and kept in repair by the respective counties in which they are located”; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the County Commission to prioritize road improvements based on road conditions, classification and the needs of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the NMDOT has requested that Valencia County utilize all available funding sources at its discretion for County road improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the County for the County Commission to upgrade its road system, and endorse an aggressive Road Improvement Program; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of Valencia County that:

1. The **2014 Valencia County Road Projects** is of a high priority and is predicated off current needs and road conditions

**2014 Road Projects listed:**

*District I:*

- Sichler Rd. \$ 72,260.54 (repair and seal existing pavement)
  - Dalies Rd. \$135,252.87 (repair road, add millings)
- \$207,513.41**

**District I Balance for 2015 = \$0**

*District II:*

- Airport Rd. \$ 57,564.16 (pulverize chip seal, put down millings)
  - Tome Dr. \$ 27,254.80 (pulverize chip seal, put down millings)
  - Mission Park Loop \$ 43,262.16 (put down millings)
- \$128,081.12**

**District II Balance for 2015 = \$14,022.44**

*District III:*

- James St. \$ 68,000.00 (pave section between Frontage Rd. to existing pavement)
  - Sonnenburg Loop \$157,557.28 (put down millings on existing dirt section)
- \$225,557.28**

**District III Balance for 2015 = \$0**

*District IV:*

- La Paloma Ct. \$ 8,598.08 (put down millings)
  - Ranchitos Rd. \$29,717.28 (put down millings)
- \$38,315.36**

**District IV Balance for 2015 = \$77,936.77**

*District V:*

- Palomas Rd. \$115,426.85 (pave section)
  - Nancy St. \$ 19,250.00 (repair and seal existing pavement)
- \$134,676.85**

**District V Balance for 2015 = \$7719.55**


**TOTAL 2014 VALENCIA COUNTY ROAD PROJECTS = \$734,144.02**


**TOTAL REMAINING ROAD PROJECT FUNDS FOR 2015 = \$99,678.76**
